Located in Cedar Rapids, Iowa, Kirkwood Community College serves over 14,000 students across 6 different campus locations.

Zoe Harris joined Kirkwood in July of 2021 as the institution's first Environmental Health and Safety Coordinator. "When I joined Kirkwood, one of my initial

goals was to create a chemical inventory database for the institution," said Zoe.

Kirkwood Community College selected CampusOptics in November of 2021 to track chemical inventory and manage its safety inspections. The institution went live with the system in February of 2022 after a brief 3-month implementation process.
